- Students are required to have a scientific Texas Instruments TI-30XIIS calculator for use in class (as of 5/23/23 these are 50% off on Amazon and the price is \$10.97)
- Students who have access to a Texas Instruments TI-84 Plus or TI-84 Plus CE Graphing Calculator are encouraged to bring it, and they may choose to use it for daily work. Students who plan to study math beyond Algebra 2 and Personal Finance are encouraged to begin with this graphing calculator now, so that they can become comfortable with it; however, this graphing calculator is not required for Mrs. Thornton's Algebra 1 Class.
- **Geometry:** Students are encouraged to have a protractor & compass set of their own to use at home.

Students are expected to have the following items for use in class each day:

- TI-30XIIS, TI-84 Plus, or TI-84 Plus CE
- Notebook paper
- Graphing paper
- Pencil
- Straight Edge or Ruler
- Class binder with dividers

Advanced Mathematical Decision Making (Personal Finance) :
